

Municipal Art Collection

ENTRANCE

The second floor of the Palazzo Comunale di Bologna (the town hall) hosts the Municipal Art Collection. From the main entrance of the building you have to cross the courtyard (with paving slabs, flat, but slightly irregular) and go right. You'll find two long flights of short steps separated by a long corridor. The flights have left and right handrails almost everywhere. A lift is also available.

Once you reach the second floor, you can enter (on the left coming from the stairs, on the right coming out of the elevator) the Sala Farnese (entirely decorated with frescoes) through a double door, 97 cm and 102 cm wide per door. Beyond it there is a second door, always open, with a width of 120 cm. In the middle of the room, on the right, is the Farnese Chapel, used as a place for public meetings. At the end of the Farnese hall, with a view from the top, you can admire Piazza Maggiore. At the end of the hall, on the right, there is the ticket office of the museum, while on the left there is the entrance to the exhibition.

At the ticket office, which also houses the bookshop, there is a 110 cm wide double door (always open). The desk of the ticket counter, which is also an information point, is 85 cm high.

The museum entrance has a door, always open, with a width of 182 cm. Through the door you'll find a 170 cm wide ramp with a slope of about 16.5%. The door to the first room has a width of cm. 133.

HALLS

Room 1 is very large so that moving is very easy.

Room 2 can be reached via a flat walkway of 132 cm. At the end of the second room you can go into room 4 by a doorway of 133 cm.

Before entering room 4 on the left, through a 125 cm doorway, you can visit hall 17, called "urban" or of "coats of arms".

Room 4 gives access to room 5 with a doorway of 130 cm.

From room 5 you reach room 6 with two doorways, both 124 cm wide. The same kind of doorway is from room 6 to room 7. The doorway is the same also from room 7 to 8, while that from room 8 to 9 is 123 cm.

Room 10 can be reached through a doorway of 121 cm, followed by a 20 cm high step without a handrail. After the entry point to room 10, still in room 9, there is a second doorway of 84 cm. which faces a 120 cm wide safety exit (with a fire escape stair).

To reach room 11 from this point of the exhibition you must go back to room 4. At the end of this, you can access the room by a 129 wide ramp with a slope of about 30%.

From room 11 you arrive in room 12 through a flat passageway of 106 cm width. Those from room 12 to 13, from 13 to 14, from 14 to 15 and from 15 to 16 are all flat and measure respectively 103 cm, 112 cm, 111 cm and 113 cm.

When you reach room 16, your visit to this part of the museum comes to an end. To exit or reach room 3 you have to return along the same way.

Room 3, in fact, is on the left of room 2 and can be reached by going up a 230 cm wide ramp with a slope of about 13%, followed by a passageway of 204 cm.

From room 3 you get to room 18 by a doorway of 130 cm.

From room 18 you reach room 19 through a doorway of 109 cm. From here you go to room 20 through two doorways from 107 cm to 98 cm wide.

From room 19 you reach the exit of the exhibition path crossing three rooms (23, 24, 25) and their flat passageway of 107, 130 and 137 cm width

The museum's exit is a double door with a flat passage of 120 cm width.

To access the room 21, cross the Farnese chapel with a flat passage of 116 cm.

At various points in the museum paper information sheets are available.

LIFT/AID

From the main entrance to Palazzo D'Accursio go straight along the courtyard (which has paving slabs, flat, slightly irregular). Beyond it, on the left, a ramp (130 cm wide, with a slope of 25% about) gives access to the corridor at the end of which you find the lift.

For those arriving by car from Via Ugo Bassi or via IV Novembre, the lift is on the right along the way to the courtyard. Once you reach the courtyard the two flights of stairs, instead, are on the left.

The use of the lift is free. It connects the ground floor to the second floor (where the museum is).

The entrance to the elevator has a width of 100 cm. The space inside the lift measures $160 \text{ cm} \times 135 \text{ cm}$. The button panel, with braille signs in relief, has a maximum height of 124 cm (where the emergency button is). The arrival signal at the floor is visual. Pay close attention to which floor the elevator is opening, as it can also be called by users on the first floor

TOILETS

The toilets are at the end of the Farnese Chapel on the right. You walk through a room at the end of which a heavy double door with a width of 97 cm and 94 cm per door leads to a corridor. At the end of it there is the entrance door to the ante-bathroom common to all three restrooms (the width is 84 cm). There are toilets for men, women and disabled.

<u>Accessible toilets</u>: the key must be requested at the ticket office. The front door is 80 cm wide. The wall-mounted sink, 80 cm high, has a lever tap and the space in front of it is 158 cm. The toilet is 50 cm high, with a front space of 140 cm, on the right 167 cm and on the left 24 cm. The grab bars are on the left and right of the toilet and continue along all the walls.

You enter the ante-bathroom common to men's and women's toilets by going through a swinging door (saloon-type), 72 cm large. In the ante-bathroom there are two wall-mounted sinks, 80 cm high, with lever taps and a front space of 170 cm.

Men's toilet: the entrance door is 65 wide. The toilet is 38 cm high. The space in front of the toilet is 108 cm, that on the right 31 cm, that on the left 27 cm.

 $\underline{\text{Women's toilet}}$: the entrance door is 66 cm wide. The toilet is 38 cm high. The space in front of the toilet is 95 cm, that on the right 25 cm, that on the left of 33 cm.
