



Risorgimento Civic Museum

The Museum has a manual wheelchair for internal mobility.

ENTRANCE

The flooring in front of the museum consists in regular cobblestones on level ground. Before the entrance door there is a step 15 cm high, without handrail.

The call system consists in a doorbell (120 cm high).

People in wheelchairs gain access through the gate on the left. It is necessary to request staff support using the doorbell. From the gate, through a 125 cm door, you can enter the conference/temporary exhibit hall. To access the actual exhibition space, it is necessary to go up two 15 cm steps or to request the installation of a mobile ramp that, once installed, has a slope of more than 25%.

The entrance to the exhibit space is a manual swinging door (120 cm), but it is always open.

TICKET COUNTER

Beyond the entrance door on the right there is a glass door (90 cm) through which you arrive at the ticket office with a 110 cm high counter.

ROOMS

The furniture and the display cases are arranged in such a way as to ensure a comfortable view of the exhibit and optimal circulation.

To reach the second room (stamp collection), located on the right side of the building, it is necessary to go up two 15 cm steps or to request the installation of a mobile ramp that, once installed, has a slope of more than 25%.

RESTROOMS

There are no restrooms suitable for disabled persons.

The restrooms are located in the basement, reachable from the conference/temporary exhibit hall through a staircase of 17 steps measuring 18 cm high, with a handrail at a height of 90 cm on the right.
