Are there passageways narrower than 80 cm? **YES**

What is the min and max height of the items on display? **40/300 cm**

Which kind of lighting system is there? **Traditional, led, neon**

Are there routes of visit in outside areas? **YES**

If so, which kind of paving is there? **Paved roads**

How far is the nearest bus stop? **Approximately 500 mt (bus 38)**
